



**Suranaree University of Technology Announcement**

**Preventive and Monitoring Measures in Response to the Coronavirus COVID-19**  
**Outbreak**  
**(Announcement No. 18)**

Following the Suranaree University of Technology Announcement on Preventive and Monitoring Measures in Response to the Coronavirus COVID-19 Outbreak No. 17 dated on August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 that requests all staff to work from home (WFH) from August 1<sup>st</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup>, 2021, unfortunately it has appeared that the COVID-19 situation has not been resolved and the number of new cases is still rising. Suranaree University of Technology (SUT), therefore, deems it crucial to issue this additional announcement on preventive measures against the new spread of COVID-19 to reduce the risk of infection among students and staff, as follows:

1. The Heads of all the units in SUT will continue assigning work to their staff to do at home from August 15<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021 following Work from Home (WFH) practice by placing emphasis on the quality of work not less than from normal working on campus. They are required to submit a weekly report on the work achieved. For important work, alternating work days and shifts of the staff in the units is recommended, by limiting the number at 25% of the staff in the unit to come to work in a day and placing priority on the health safety of the staff. However, all the services of Suranaree University of Technology Hospital (SUTH) will be offered as usual by placing priority on the health safety of its staff.

2. All SUT staff are required to comply with the Suranaree University of Technology Announcements on Preventive and Monitoring Measures in Response to the Coronavirus COVID-19 Outbreak No. 11 and No. 12, as well as other SUT's measures related to COVID-19 situations announced earlier, in the parts that do not conflict with this current Announcement.

SUT thanks everyone and all the units in the university for their awareness and concern on this critical issue and for their cooperation in practicing these measures strictly. Your notification and report of COVID-19 suspected cases to SUT COVID-19 Surveillance Team and SUTH at 044-376555 will be greatly appreciated. Thank you for working together to keep our SUT free from COVID-19.
