



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN



NATIONAL TAIWAN UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY, TAIWAN
AND
SURANAREE UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY, THAILAND

This Memorandum of Understanding is made on this 15 day of December 2008, between National Taiwan University of Science & Technology and Suranaree University of Technology, hereinafter referred to as "NTUST" and "SUT".

1. NTUST and SUT hereby agree to encourage academic cooperation through research and study in furtherance of the advancement of learning as stated below:
 - (a) To encourage visits by faculty from one university to the other for the purpose of engaging in research;
 - (b) To facilitate the admission of qualified students from one university to the other for the purpose of enrolling in undergraduate and graduate programs, and in the case of advanced graduate students, participating in research;
 - (c) To foster the exchange of academic publications and scholarly information; and
 - (d) To promote other academic activities which enhance the above mentioned goals.
2. Both universities acknowledge that the visit by faculty and students from one university to the other shall be subject to the entry and visa regulations of Thailand and Taiwan and shall comply with the regulations and policies of SUT and NTUST.
3. Both universities agree that all expenses, including research material, international and domestic travel, per diem, honoraria and all other costs, shall be the responsibility of the participating scholars and determined on a case-by-case basis. However, each side will make its best efforts to make available university accommodation to visiting faculty and students.
4. Both universities agree to review this Memorandum of Understanding after five years following the date of signing, and acknowledge that this Memorandum is subject to revision and termination at any time by mutual consent or by 90 days' written notice by either party.
5. Both universities agree that this Memorandum of Understanding is incorporated into, and will provide the foundation and framework for, projects developed by academic and administrative units from the two universities and documented in other subsequent Agreements.
