MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON STUDENT EXCHANGE

BETWEEN

INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE AND INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING, SURANAREE UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY, THAILAND

AND

FACULTY OF ENGINEERING SCIENCES, INTERDISCIPLINARY GRADUATE SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING SCIENCES, FACULTY OF ENGINEERING, GRADUATE SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING, FACULTY OF SCIENCES, GRADUATE SCHOOL OF SCIENCES, SCHOOL OF SCIENCES, INSTITUTE FOR MATERIALS CHEMISTRY AND ENGINEERING, AND RESEARCH INSTITUTE FOR APPLIED MECHANICS, KYUSHU UNIVERSITY, JAPAN

The agreement for the academic exchange program between Institute of Science and Institute of Engineering, Suranaree University of Technology, Thailand and Faculty of Engineering Sciences, Interdisciplinary Graduate School of Engineering Sciences, Faculty of Engineering, Graduate School of Engineering, School of Engineering, Faculty of Sciences, Graduate School of Sciences, School of Sciences, Institute for Materials Chemistry and Engineering, and Research Institute for Applied Mechanics, Kyushu University, Japan, as it relates to the exchange of students, shall be implemented as follows:

Article 1

The students participating in the exchange program under the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be selected initially by the home university, and the host university shall make final admission decisions in each case.

Article 2

Each year, not more than 5 students may be enrolled as non-degree students at the partner university, and the number of the students shall be modified by mutual consultation in advance.

Article 3

The period of enrollment of the students shall not exceed one year.

Article 4

The host university shall waive application, matriculation, and tuition fees for the students.

Article 5

The host University shall appoint a qualified advisor and provide an appropriate course of study.

Article 6

In order to carry out the study, each student shall possess sufficient language ability requested by the host university to complete the appropriate course of study.

Article 7

Each university agrees to provide documentation of course work completed by the students at the host university.

Article 8

The host university shall make efforts to ensure that the students are provided assistance in finding adequate housing on or near the campus.

Article 9

Each university agrees to provide appropriate information on the academic performance of the students.

Article 10

Actual implementation on each student exchange will be discussed and approved mutually by both universities.
