Center for International Affairs Measures to Access Personnel data.

To comply with the Personal Data Protection at 2019, the Center for International Affairs, as a supporting unit established to promote teaching and activities of Suranaree University of Technology by providing international affairs services, must record or store and retrieve service recipients' information for operations carried out by the center. Therefore, in order to enable secure use of data, the following measures have been set for stakeholders to import data into the system.

- 1. The personnel responsible for storing the data of the service provider must not record or store sensitive personal information (Section 26).
- 2. The personnel responsible for recording and storing data must conceal the data related to the service recipient to prohibit from any identification, whether directly or indirectly (Section 6) and disclosing information to anyone other than the owner.
- 3. Any personnel accessing the information of service recipients who intend to use the recipient's data for the preparation of information, services, and communication, to the service recipient must be authorized by the director of the center or the assignee.
- 4. Personnel are not allowed to remove, disclose and disseminate personal information to third parties or external organizations without the permission of the director of the center.
