Funding within ASEA-UNINET Projects

ASEA-UNINET Austria aims to promote research and teaching activities between the member universities in Austria and South-East Asia. Funding within ASEA-UNINET projects is offered for doctoral students and researchers (Clinical traineeship projects are exempt from this restriction) from all fields of study/research: Natural Sciences, Technical Sciences, Human Medicine, Health Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, Social Sciences, Humanities, Arts

Duration	1 or 3 months. Age limit is 50 for postdocs!
Grant amount	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1,250 EUR per month• accident and health insurance• Scholarship holders have to pay the costs for accommodation and insurance themselves.• The OeAD can help with taking out a health insurance that is accepted by the Austrian authorities.• if necessary the OeAD-GmbH will endeavor to provide accommodation on a cost basis of 250 to 600 EUR, additional monthly administration fee of 18 EUR• Scholarship holders will receive a travel costs subsidy of maximum 1.000 EUR

Bernd Rode Award

Target group

Researchers with outstanding scientific and higher education collaborations between its Austrian and South-East-Asian or Pakistani member universities funded by ASEA-UNINET. The Award is given every 18 months in three different categories:

- **Junior** (Individual contributions conducted within the framework of ASEA-UNINET by applicants up to 5 years after completion of their PhD studies)
- **Senior** (Individual contributions, including all publications and projects carried out in the framework of ASEA-UNINET by applicants over a period of 5 years after completion of their PhD studies)
- **Project-based collaborative research** conducted in the framework of ASEA-UNINET

Grant amount

Max of 4,500 EUR

Deadline

Not yet launched.

Last year's deadline was on 1st Dec 2021- 1st March 2022, Notification on May 15.

Award ceremony on July 27.

Up to 5 Mio. Euro for six years in total (for consortia of HEIs: 750 Euro/ month/student and for scholarship holders: 1.400 Euro/month)
