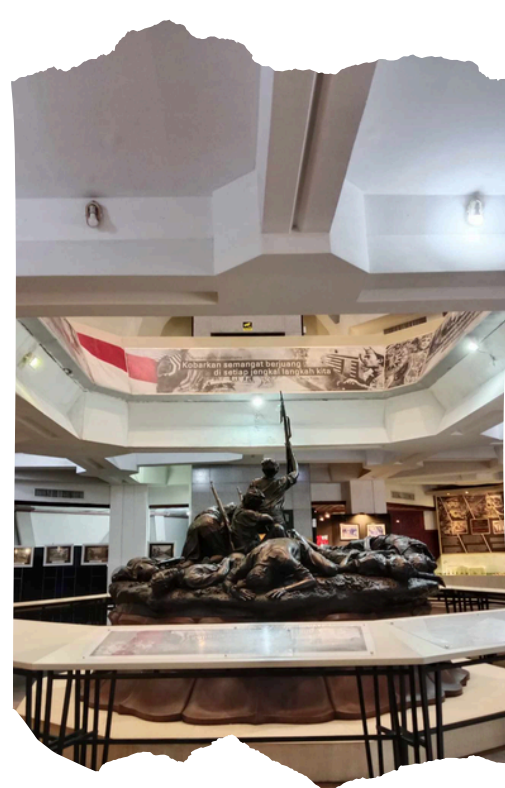
Learning

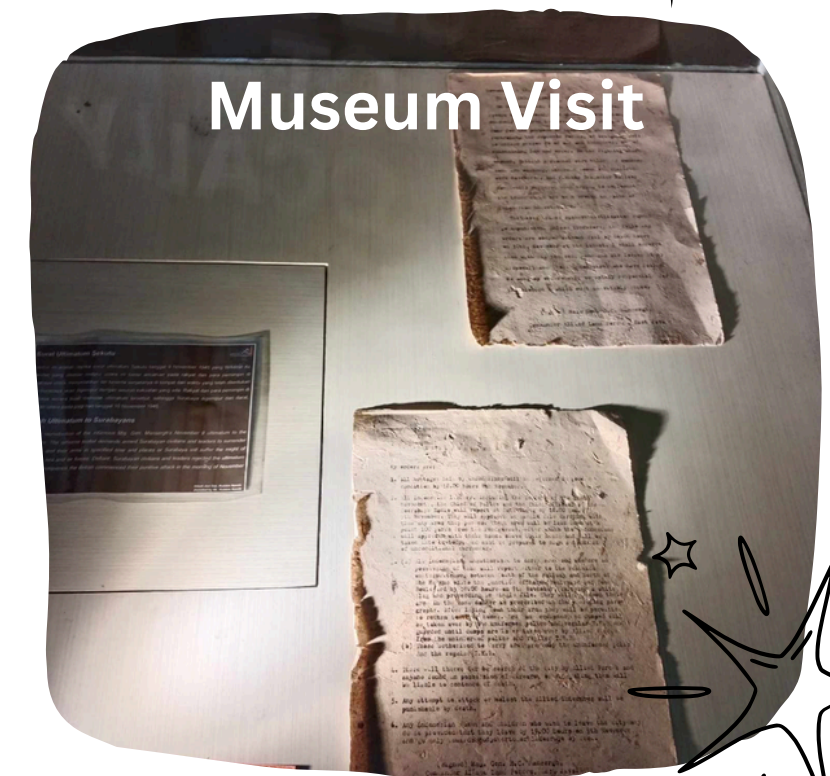

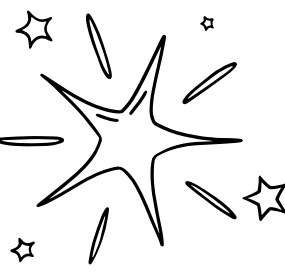
