## DRIVE RIGHT: TRAFFIC LAWS, SAFETY, AND RESPONSIBILITY



On March 27, 2026, Center for International Affairs (CIA) successfully hosted “Drive Right: Traffic Laws, Safety, and Responsibility”, a meaningful session aimed at raising awareness among students, especially within our international community.



The event covered how to legally purchase a motorcycle in Thailand, the process of obtaining compulsory motor insurance (Por Ror Bor), and Key legal requirements for vehicle ownership and registration. Our expert speakers provided practical guidance to help students confidently and legally navigate transportation in Thailand.

In addition, the session offered important information for international students on essential traffic laws in Thailand and the importance of being a responsible road user.



Students also learned about Thailand's traffic penalty point system, including how violations can lead to point deductions and legal consequences.

A particularly powerful part of the session came from international students who courageously shared their personal accident experiences.
